



Guidelines for Full Paper Submission

General Requirements

- Word Count: Typically ranges from 5,000 to 8,000 words, excluding footnotes and references
- Font: Kruti Dev or Times New Roman, size 12 points
- Line Spacing: Single-spaced
- Margins: 1 inch (2.5 cm) on all sides

Structure

- Title Page: Include title, author names, affiliations, and contact details
- Abstract: 300-500 words, summarizing research purpose, methods, results and conclusions
- Keywords: 3-10 keywords for indexing purposes
- Introduction: Introduce topic, define research gap, and outline paper's contributions
- Main Body: Divided into sections and subsections with logical headings
- Conclusion: Summarize findings, implications, and suggestions for future research
- References: Formatted according
- Submission Format: Typically, MS Word, following specified template
- Margins: 1 inch (2.5 cm) on all sides Structure.
