



- All submissions must be prepared in Microsoft Word format, using Kruti Dev in Hindi, Times New Roman in English, font size 12 to 14 and 1.5 line spacing.
- Citations and referencing should be in APA 7th edition style.
- Accepted abstracts will be notified via email within two weeks of submission.

## *Guidelines for Full Paper Submission*

### **General Requirements**

- **Word Count:** Typically ranges from 5,000 to 8,000 words, excluding footnotes and references
- **Font:** Kruti Dev or Times New Roman, size 12 points
- **Line Spacing:** Single-spaced
- **Margins:** 1 inch (2.5 cm) on all sides

### **Structure**

- **Title Page:** Include title, author names, affiliations, and contact details
- **Abstract:** 300-500 words, summarizing research purpose, methods, results and conclusions
- **Keywords:** 3-10 keywords for indexing purposes
- **Introduction:** Introduce topic, define research gap, and outline paper's contributions
- **Main Body:** Divided into sections and subsections with logical headings
- **Conclusion:** Summarize findings, implications, and suggestions for future research
- **References:** Formatted according
- **Submission Format:** Typically, MS Word, following specified template
- **Margins:** 1 inch (2.5 cm) on all sides Structure.
