- **Postgraduate:** Master of Business Administration (**MBA**); Master in Human Resource Development (**MBA-HRD**); Master in Business Administration-International Business (**MBA-IB**); Master in Business Administration – Logistics and Supply Chain Management (**MBA-LSCM**); Master in Business Administration- Finance (MBA-Finance); Master of Computer Applications (**MCA**), and
- **Postgraduate Integrated courses: MBA (Integrated) and MCA (Integrated).**

Admission to the MBA program typically requires a valid score in national-level entrance exams such as **CMAT, MAT, or CAT**, followed by Group Discussion (GD) and Personal Interview (PI) rounds. But for MCA, BCA, BBA and Integrated BBA+MBA and Integrated BCA+MCA prospective students have to take and qualify in an institution organized Written Test.

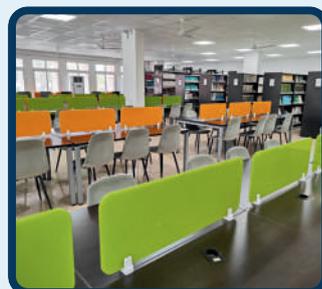
## INFRASTRUCTURE & FACILITIES

## 1. POST GRADUATE PROGRAMMES

### I. Master of Business Administration (MBA) - Two-Year Full-Time

The **MBA** program at LNMI is designed to transform graduates into competent and responsible business leaders, equipped to handle complex challenges across various functional areas.

#### Eligibility Criteria

- Recognized Bachelor's Degree of Minimum 3 Years Duration.
- Minimum of 50% Marks in Aggregate (45% for SC / ST / EBC / Divyang Candidates).
- MAT Score (September, 2025 onwards) / CMAT / CAT 2025 Score is required.

#### MBA Courses Offered (Dual Specialization possible)

- **MBA (General):** Core management subjects with broad exposure across all domains.
- **MBA (International Business - IB):** Focus on global trade, EXIM policy, international finance, and cross-cultural management.
- **MBA (Human Resource Development - HRD):** Specialized training in talent acquisition, performance management, industrial relations, and organizational behavior.
- **MBA (Finance):** Deep dive into corporate finance, investment analysis, financial markets, and wealth management.
- **MBA (Logistics and Supply Chain Management - LSCM):** Specialized knowledge in procurement, warehousing, transport, and optimizing supply chain networks.

## II. Master of Computer Applications (MCA) - Two-Year Full-Time

The **MCA** program is a postgraduate course focused on advanced concepts in computer science, software engineering, and modern IT applications, preparing students for high-level technical and managerial roles in the IT industry.

### Eligibility Criteria

- Recognized Bachelor's Degree of Minimum 3 Years Duration with Mathematics at 10+2 Level or at Graduation Level.
- Minimum of 50% Marks in Aggregate (45% for SC / ST / EBC / Divyang Candidates).

### Key Focus Areas

- Advanced Data Structures and Algorithms
- Software Engineering and DevOps
- Cloud Computing and Big Data Analytics
- Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Machine Learning (ML)
- Cyber Security and Network Management
- Advanced Database Management Systems (DBMS)



**LNMI, Patna** has collaborated with **C-DAC (Centre for Development of Advanced Computing)**, an R&D organization under MeitY, Govt. of India, to offer specialized certification courses in Intelligent Systems & Engineering Technologies for MCA Students.

## III. Integrated BBA + MBA Programme - Five-Year Full-Time

This **integrated** program offers an accelerated, continuous learning path that combines the fundamentals of undergraduate business studies (**BBA**) with the advanced specialization of the **MBA**, leading to both degrees in five years.

### Eligibility Criteria

- Passed 10+2 or equivalent examination from a recognized board.
- Minimum of 45% marks in aggregate (40% for SC / ST / EBC / Divyang candidates).

### Structure

The program allows students to secure their Master's degree seamlessly, ensuring in-depth exposure to business concepts early in their academic journey.

## IV. Integrated BCA + MCA Programme - Five-Year Full-Time

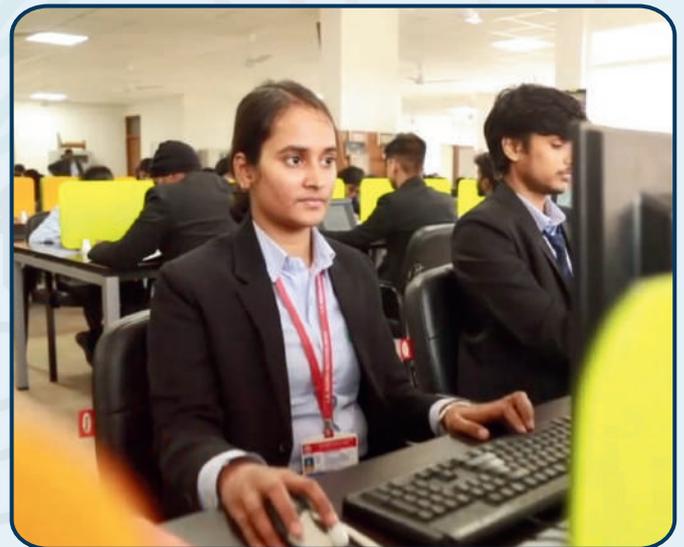
The integrated **BCA + MCA** program is designed for students seeking comprehensive expertise in computer applications. It provides a continuous and robust curriculum spanning core IT foundations (**BCA**) and advanced computing and technical skills (**MCA**).

### Eligibility Criteria

- 10+2 or appeared or equivalent examination from a recognized board.
- Minimum of 45% marks in aggregate (40% for SC / ST / EBC / Divyang candidates).

### Structure

This program offers a strong technical foundation followed by specialized training in emerging technologies like AI/ML and Data Science, optimizing time and preparing students for advanced technical roles.





## 2. UNDER GRADUATE PROGRAMMES (BCA & BBA)

### I. Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) - Three-Year Full-Time

The **BBA** program provides a comprehensive foundation in business fundamentals, preparing students for entry-level managerial roles or further postgraduate studies.

#### Eligibility Criteria

- Passed 10+2 examination from a recognized board.
- Minimum of 45% marks in aggregate (40% for SC / ST / EBC / Divyang candidates).

#### Key Focus Areas

- Principles of Management and Organisational Behaviour
- Business Economics and Quantitative Methods
- Fundamentals of Marketing and HR
- Basic Accounting and Corporate Finance

### II. Bachelor of Computer Applications (BCA) - Three-Year Full-Time

The **BCA** program is structured to provide a strong theoretical and practical understanding of computer science, software development, and modern IT applications.

#### Eligibility Criteria

- 10+2 or appeared or equivalent examination from a recognized board.
- Minimum of 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC /ST / EBC / Divyang candidates).
- Mathematics as a compulsory subject at the 10+2 level is mandatory.

#### Key Focus Areas

- Programming in C, Python, and Java
- Database Management Systems (DBMS)
- Web Development (HTML, CSS, JavaScript)
- Data Structures and Algorithms
- Computer Networks and Operating Systems

# THE ADMISSION PROCESS 2026 - 2027

**Admission to LNMI is strictly merit-based, ensuring transparency and fairness.**

The admission process is centrally managed for all courses and is based on merit, entrance test scores, and performance in the personal assessment rounds.

## 1. General Admission Procedure

- **Application:** The prospectus and application form can be downloaded from the Institute website, [www.lnmipat.ac.in](http://www.lnmipat.ac.in) or can be collected from the institute's reception area.
- **Application Submission:** The on-line application form must be submitted along with the requisite application fee.
- **Application Fee:** ₹1500/- (for General / OBC candidates) or ₹750/- (for SC / ST candidates).
- **Rejection:** Online applications submitted without the fee are summarily rejected.
- **Appearing Candidates:** Candidates appearing in their final year of the qualifying examination may also apply, but they must produce their passing certificate at the time of admission.
- **Reservation:** Reservations are applicable as per the Government of Bihar Rules.
- **NRI/PIO:** NRI / PIO seats are available in the PG Courses as per AICTE norms.

### 5.2. Fine for Late Payments

- Participants who fail to pay the installment on or before the due date will be debarred from appearing in the semester examination and attending the subsequent semester's classes. Such debarment shall be revoked only upon payment of the pending installment along with a fine of ₹1,500.
- A grace period of seven days is allowed after the specified date to deposit the installments with a fine:

**Fine of ₹500/- for up to 5 days.**

**Fine of ₹1,000/- for up to 10 days.**



### 5.3. Counselling Fees for extension of admission due date.

- **Counselling Fee: ₹10,000/-** (Rupees Ten Thousand only) for holding seat (maximum for 7 days).
- **Purpose:** This fee is required for students willing to avail an extension of the admission time.
- **Refund Policy:** The counselling fee is non-refundable.
- **Adjustment:** It is adjusted towards the tuition fee if the admission is finalized. AICTE norms are followed for other fee refunds in case of admission cancellation.

### 5.4. Mode of Payment

# TEACHING PEDAGOGY EXAMINATION AND ASSESSMENT

## 1. Teaching Pedagogy and Methodology

The Institute has been granted autonomy by the **Aryabhata Knowledge University (AKU), Patna**, in respect of the conduct of examinations, study programmes, and publication of results. The degrees are, however, **awarded by the Aryabhata Knowledge University, Patna.**

### 2.1. Examination

- All theory, project, viva voce, and practical examinations are conducted by the **Institute itself.**
- Examinations for the prescribed subjects are held at the **end of each semester.**
- The duration of a theory paper examination is **three (3) hours.**

### 2.2. Assessment Components and Weightage

The final grade in each subject is based on a composite evaluation structure:

- **Internal Assessment:** The evaluation responsibility lies with a committee consisting of concerned faculty members.
- **Project Report & Viva-Voce:** All participants are required to undertake project work as per the syllabus. Evaluation of the Project Report and subsequent **Viva-Voce** is conducted by a dedicated Board of Examiners appointed for this purpose.

## 2.3. Examination Rules

RULE	DESCRIPTION
<b>Sent-up (Minimum Attendance)</b>	A minimum of <b>75% attendance</b> of total classes held in <b>all papers</b> of the semester is mandatory to be eligible for the semester-end examination.
<b>Carry-over Examination</b>	A participant who fails or fails to appear in a semester examination may appear in the carry-over examination without attending classes. A student with attendance shortage may be allowed to take the carry-over exam only with explicit permission from the competent authority.
<b>Make-up Examination</b>	A participant who passes in all individual papers (40% being the pass marks) but fails to obtain the required <b>aggregate percentage of 45%</b> in any semester may be allowed to appear in a Make-up Examination for one or a maximum of three papers to overcome the deficiency.
<b>Re-totalling of Marks</b>	Applications for re-totalling of marks must be submitted to the Institute within <b>30 days</b> of the result publication.
<b>Unfair Means Cases</b>	Cases involving the use of unfair means are dealt with severity according to the rules and regulations issued by the University and the State Government of Bihar.

## 2.4. Results & Certificates

- **Result & Mark-Sheet:** The Institute publishes the list of successful participants in order of merit. Marks-sheets are issued upon payment of the prescribed fee and submission of a **“NO DUES”** certificate from the Library, Admission Section, and Computer Centre.
- **Provisional Certificate:** This certificate shall be issued to successful participants upon payment of the prescribed fee.
